Barbara Fox is the producer/director of *Mystery on the Menu*, an interactive theater company she founded in Washington D.C. in 1986. She writes and acts in plays which have been presented at hotels, resorts, museums, aboard trains and cruise ships and for corporate and private events. Since moving to Florida ten years ago, Barbara developed the “*One Woman Murder Mystery Series*”, in which audience members read various parts. Barbara plays one of the characters and acts out the story of a “murder”.

When Barbara isn’t writing or acting, she lives a “vacation life in Miami Beach”. She is an avid dancer and is a weekly participant of the line dancing class at Senior Partners.
