1. Access to Care Tactics

Improve access to affordable healthcare

- Implementation of care coordination and transitional care program
- Assistance with navigation and education of health insurance process
- Continued education for the uninsured/underinsured patients about the expanded MHS primary care locations and hours



2. Preventative Care Tactics

Improve access to preventative care in SBHD

- Prenatal care for the prevention of low birthweight babies
- Continue to address low immunization rates for children & adults
- Education for the prevention of opioid misuse



3. Community Health Education Tactics

Promote wellness through patient education

- Chronic disease self-management education offered at various times and locations to increase patient's opportunities to attend
- Health promotion and wellness group activities at all primary care centers
- Education for the prevention of sexually transmitted infections (STI)



4. Quality of Care Tactics

Improve the quality of care for all patients

- Consideration of diversity issues (gender, expression, LGBTQ)
- Develop an Integrated care system
- Impact of social determinants on population health



5. Emergency Response Tactics

 To serve as a leader in emergency response (including education of response personnel)

- Design the All Hazard Regional Response Recovery System vehicle for implementation
- Educate emergency response personnel through the use of simulation
